## Dear Friends,

MHA has experienced exponential growth in the recent years. The addition of several new programs and the growth of existing ones have resulted in a 64% increase in the number of people MHA served from FY02 to FY08. From FY00 to FY08 the number of clients MHA served on site grew by 129%, for an average annual growth in services of 16.1%; however, during this same period, our physical space grew from 5,100 square feet to 7,100 square feet, an annual average growth rate of only 4.9%, clearly not keeping pace with the programmatic and client growth.

We have been using locations in the community to offer our Supervised Visitation/ Monitored Exchange program, parenting classes and much of our child care provider training. We have not been able to offer group therapy due to space limitations, and our Survivors of Suicide Support Group has moved four times in as many years. Our current buildings lack parking and are not handicapped accessible.

Clearly the need for our services is great and continues to grow, especially in this economic climate. The Board, therefore, began a search for new premises that could accommodate all of MHA's programs and services under one roof with easy accessibility for our clients. In the fall of 2008, and after viewing many properties, we gained site control of an 11,000 square foot building, ripe for renovation (it needs some TLC – well, a lot of TLC!), with easy access, plenty of parking and 4,000 square feet available for future expansion.

Obviously, we face a challenging task to raise the necessary funds to purchase and renovate the new building, but the support we have received thus far is very encouraging. We are very grateful to the Ausherman Family Foundation, who awarded MHA a very generous challenge grant, half of which our board matched within three months. We also have received a \$250,000 bond bill from the State and \$50,000 in City Community Development Block Grant Funds.

Our hope is to have sufficient funding in place to proceed with a capital campaign in the fall of 2009. We have faith that at that time our very generous community will continue to be supportive of our efforts to provide the best educational, preventive and primary mental health care and family support services in Frederick. In the meantime, please accept our sincere thanks for all you have done to help MHA serve our community – we couldn't do it without you.

Be on the lookout for more, hopefully very good, news about our new space and exciting plans for the future!




